The ideal candidate is technically proficient, highly organized, detail-oriented, and passionate about using media to help advance the Gospel.

Key Responsibilities

Video Editing & Production

- Edit high-quality video content for multiple digital platforms.
- Create engaging short-form content for:
 - Instagram Reels
 - TikTok
 - YouTube Shorts
 - Facebook Reels
 - X
- Edit medium-form content including:
 - Teaching clips
 - Podcast segments
 - Event highlights
 - Ministry feature videos
- Transform long-form content into multiple platform-specific clips.
- Maintain a consistent editing style that aligns with TIL branding and messaging.
- Incorporate captions, graphics, transitions, music, and visual enhancements as appropriate.
- Ensure all content meets quality standards for audio, pacing, storytelling, and audience engagement.

- Maintain an organized editing workflow and project management system.
